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Course Outline

Endoscopic surgery has become an integral part of a gynaecologist's practice. Procedures like Laparoscopic Myomectomy, Laparoscopic Hysterectomy and Hysteroscopy are of top priority for patient relief as the patient wants earlier recovery and wants to be discharged in few days.

This four day course on operative techniques in gynecological endoscopy encompasses an "all-in-one" approach to fulfill the dreams of any gynecological surgeon to practice safe laparoscopic and hysteroscopy surgical procedures.

The purpose of this program is to reduce the concern of visual-spatial orientation and better hand eye coordination by providing comprehensive training that includes lectures, instructional videos, lab exercises, hands on training, live demonstrations and one on one discussions with the experts. All this will help to improve the confidence and competence of the gynaecologist so that they can implement all this in their own operative rooms.

- ▶ To understand the basic anatomy of gynecological system.
- ▶ To understand basic principles of energy sources
- ▶ To gain proficiency in two-hand dissection and improve hand-eye co-ordination.
- ▶ To orient oneself with knot-tying and suturing.
