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Workshop Outline

If a laparoscopic surgeon wants to expertise in laparoscopic surgery his aim should be repair of Hernia. A common surgical condition, almost always encountered by a surgeon in practice, laparoscopic repair should be known to a surgeon. While the steps of most laparoscopic operations are the same as those of open surgery, steps of surgery in laparoscopic hernia repair – inguinal or ventral – are different. It is essential therefore to understand the laparoscopic anatomy and procedural steps to avoid recurrences and complications. There is a wide variety of prosthetic material used in hernia surgery and thus choosing the right prosthetic material and the correct method of mesh fixation is of paramount importance. This two-day course encompasses step-by-step approach to learn the steps of laparoscopic hernia repair.
